

E-Z WINGS is currently a website tool. Version 2 will be app-based with an API connection to faasafety.gov.










2. Login to the FAA Safety Website

- Logging in first makes it easier to continue through the selection process – so click here



Accredited Activity Validation

When an airman has requested you validate an Accredited Activity, this is the page where you do that. Pending Requests are shown in the 1st list and Completed Requests appear in the 2nd list.

It is important for you to understand that you are not necessarily saying that you flew with the requesting airman. You could simply be confirming that they completed the training as indicated. In either case, you should be sure to verify that the airman successfully completed the activity, either by your own observation or by an entry in a logbook or other training record.

You begin the validation process by clicking on the "Validate Accredited Activity" icon -  - to the far right of an entry in the 1st list. This will take you to the validation page.
